

# **Gender and Sexuality in Southeast Asia**

The course is an anthropological exploration of gender and sexuality in Southeast Asia, a region with diverse cultures and long histories of gender and sexual diversity. Studies of gender and sexuality in Indonesia, the Philippines, Thailand, and Singapore will be examined. The course will lead students to investigate the relations between biology and gender, politics of reproduction and sexuality, the impact of religion, colonialism, and nation-building on gender, and the relations between intimacies, labor migration, and tourism.
